
This is my new classroom. This is where I will learn while I am in Year 6.



This is where I might put my **coat** and my **belongings**.




This is what a **desk** will look like.

I will have PE here, sometimes.






These are the toilets I will use.



**TOP TIP:** If I need to go to the toilet I need to ask one of the adults in the room.


Otherwise, it is a good idea to go at playtime or lunchtime.
