Phonics and Early Reading progression map (Years R to 2)

At Tithe Farm Primary School, we use Read, Write Inc as our phonics scheme. This scheme is an approved SSP and we use it for the teaching of Phonics and Early reading. The lesson structure is the same throughout the teaching of the scheme, using repetition and high expectations throughout.

Our goal is for the children to:

- To read all of the 44 sounds within the English language, recognising the different ways each sound can be written.
- Work out unfamiliar words quickly, including vocabulary and names.
- Read familiar words speedily.
- Read texts, including words they have been taught, fluently.

The progression map shows what the children should achieve within each half term, if they have followed the scheme from Reception. We have one-to-one tutoring groups to support children to 'keep up not catch up'.
